

LETTER OF AUTHORITY FOR APPLICANT OR USER

A Carnet may be issued in the name of an individual or a company who must be a permanent resident of India. However, it may be used by any person providing the user carries a letter from the named holder authorizing such use (see example below). The holder may also allow an Agent to handle the Carnet through the customs on his behalf, again provided that the Agent holds a Letter of Authority. Box B (Name of accredited person(s) who will use the Carnet) on the Green Front cover and the colored vouchers would then contain the statement: "Any authorized representative".
